Did you know...

There are 387,579 adults in Pennsylvania who do not speak English well or at all. Many of them are highly skilled and eager to work. The only thing holding them back is English language fluency.

Nearly 70,000 working age adults in Lancaster and Lebanon Counties do not have a high school diploma. This holds them back from job training, higher education, and a good-paying job.

More than 21% of working age adults in Lancaster and Lebanon Counties struggle with the most basic literacy skills. There are 104,183 adults who struggle with basic literacy living and working in Lancaster and Lebanon Counties.

The Solution

At the Literacy & Learning Success Centers (LLSC) of The Literacy Council of Lancaster-Lebanon, we provide opportunities for free Adult Basic Education, High School Equivalency Preparation, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), workplace education services, career pathways advising, integrated education and skills training, digital literacy, and an International Healthcare Professionals Program. At the LLSC, adults can build their literacy and language skills for work, family, and community life.

The students we serve are working age adults with significant skills gaps, working and raising families. Students who can continuously attend for at least 60 hours are making **educational gains equivalent to 1 to 2 years of K-12 schooling** with a cost of about \$2,500 per learner—a remarkable accomplishment for them and a **significant return on investment for our community**.



You Can Make a Real Difference

Public funding for Adult and Family Literacy Education falls significantly short of what is required to meet the need. In Lancaster and Lebanon Counties, our public funding supports 317 adult learners. Yet, many more people are seeking services, creating wait lists and frustration for adults who are ready to get started.

Donor investment allows us to **serve more adults**, and we want to serve every adult in our community who seeks our services.

Reaching more students means reaching for more funding.
